- Feature articles (1000-2500 words)

- Short memoirs (500-800 words)
- Each submission must have a title and should be accompanied with the author's short biography (60-90 words) and a profile picture (in high resolution)
- 3. Send appropriate topic related photos along with your text submission, if possible. These should be high resolution, in jpeg format and preferably unedited (or at least without special effects). Please do not send us images for which you do not have the copyright.
